Adam enjoyed all that life had to offer. From working abroad and exploring

new countries to regular visits home to enjoy the finest port with friends and family. He remained passionate throughout the years with his fitness and love of sport from judo and athletics to ice hockey and triathlons and of course his love of the gym. In his last chapter, with Anastasia by his side, he explored the arts, discovering a particular love for opera and ballet.

He cherished time fishing with his father and most recently playing with his grandsons and tending to the garden.

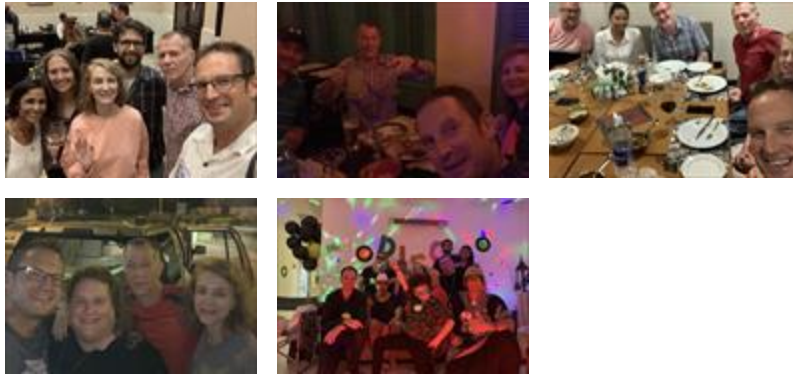
Above all else he was a man with an infectious smile, who has filled the hearts of so many and will forever remain in our loving thoughts.
