



## Anthony Thomas Castiglie

February 28, 1943 - October 20, 2024

Anthony (Tony) Thomas Castiglie, 81 of Houston passed away in the early morning hours October 20, 2024 at home with his wife by his side.

Anthony was born February 28, 1943, in Brooklyn, New York to Frank and Teresa Castiglie. He is preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife Sheila of 58 years of marriage, son, Michael, daughter-in-law, Ashley and granddaughter Zoey, sisters Palma Conroy and husband Thomas, and Camille Warmby and husband Bill. Also, many nieces, nephews and cousins in his large Italian family.

Anthony had many friends from all of his school days, and others he met along the way. Anthony was known for being an excellent friend and mentor and keeping in touch with all. He also remembered each one's birthday.

Anthony grew up in New York and graduated from St. Augustine High School, Milwaukee School of Engineering and Louisiana Tech University. He held an undergraduate and master's degrees in business management.

Out of college, he worked for Westin Geophysical, and then Touche Ross prior to opening his own consulting firm, Anton in Houston, where he spent his adult life.

Anthony was an avid collector of an array of genres, such as rhythm and blues, country, classic rock and roll and pop music. He also worked to organize his family's ancestry history.

For the past two decades, Anthony had served as an officer on the board of directors of Houston Ground Angels, after being introduced to it by his brother-in-law Dale Norwood. Anthony not only helped develop and organize the organization from its birth to a viable non-profit providing much needed services for cancer patients impacting many lives.
