Antonia (Toni) Frances LaManna died peacefully in her sleep on July 22, 2015. She was born April 3, 1941 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Even though she wasn't born in Texas, she got here as soon as she could. She was preceded in death by her parents, Anthony and Stella. Toni is survived by her sister, Rosemary Fox, nieces Elizabeth McAteer and Kathleen Fox and nephew Jerome Fox. She will be dearly missed by her very close friends Carol Carter, Sr. Mary Peters and the Cenacle Sisters throughout North America. Toni's extended family and friends in Pittsburgh and Houston will mourn her loss.

Throughout her life, Toni's kind and generous spirit had a strong impact on the lives of others. She was very involved in the parish of St. Thomas More over the years: former member of the STM Sounds of Faith Folk Group, sponsor of the CYO, and a CCD teacher. She found her joy in simple, quiet, practical service and her later years led her to Chicago where she continued this service in working with and for the Cenacle Sisters. After nine years, she returned home to Texas.
