Arthur (Athanasios) Loukas of Houston passed away May 10th, 2018. He was born in Port Arthur, Texas to Eleftherios (Fred) and Louise Witcher Loukas on June 22, 1924. Arthur is survived by his wife Charlotte Loukas; daughter Susan Weir & husband Thomas; sister Janet Spann & husband James, as well as 3 grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.

Arthur was a retired Houston Police Officer with 36 years of service and a member of the Houston Police Retired Officers Association. He served in WWII, wounded during the Battle of the Bulge. He was a lifetime member of the Battle of the Bulge Association, 83rd Infantry Association, National VFW and Local Houston Police Officers VFW 6010, Disabled American Veterans Association and Combat Infantry Association. Arthur was a longtime member of Annunciation Greek Orthodox Cathedral as well as a lifetime member of the Order of AHEPA, Chapter 29 Houston.

The Loukas family will be present to receive friends Monday, May 14, 2018 from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM with Trisagion prayers beginning at 6:30 PM. The Funeral Service will commence Tuesday, May 15, 2018 at 10:30 AM at St. Basil the Great Greek Orthodox Church, 1100 Eldridge Parkway, Houston, TX 77077.
