Belva Ann Landry, 90, of Houston, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, May 27, 2026. Belva was born on August 28, 1935, in Houston, Texas to Albert and Stella Guerin. She is preceded in death by her parents, Albert and Stella, her sister, Zaidee McClendon of Covington, Louisiana, her daughter, Dawn Renee Anderson of Longmont, Colorado and her son-in-law, Robert (Bob) Young of Katy, Texas. Belva enjoyed writing and was known by her family as quite the poet, often giving beautifully written, humorous poems to her grandchildren when they married. She was a strong woman who was loving and generous with her friends and family. She was a huge Astro's fan and loved both watching the games and having a post-game animated discussion with her family. She even has a commemorative brick at the Houston Astro's ballpark. Belva's last few years were spent at Tarrytown Estates where she enjoyed the wonderful staff and the many new friends she made there. She had always loved playing games, and there she was able to play dominos and cards and attend the numerous social events that Nikki provided for everyone.
