Bruce Halsey Crocombe died peacefully on Sunday, May 28th, 2023, loved by family and friends. He was 56 years old.

Bruce was born at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa, Oklahoma on May 2nd, 1967. Bruce grew up in Houston, Texas where he attended and played baseball at Robert E. Lee High School and went on to attend and graduate from Texas A&M University with a Bachelor of Science in Construction Science in 1989. Bruce often talked about his days in College Station and looked back on those memories and time in his life very fondly.

During his life, Bruce maintained many hobbies including fishing with his buddies, hunting trips, cooking his favorite foods, woodwork and always kept up with his favorite sports teams (Gig'em). Bruce is also survived by his brother Stephen Crocombe (married to Karin Crocombe) of Wichita, Kansas and their children:
