“ I first met Colin in the early 2000s when I was working with the BP IT team and beginning to take an interest in capital project information management. Colin was one of the “Brit Pack” in Houston, someone who truly understood the subject and, more importantly, cared deeply about it.

Over the years, we spent many hours in conversation, often trying to make sense of why BP didn't always seem to fully understand the challenges we faced. Those discussions stayed with me. On one trip to Houston, I remember being warmly welcomed by Lorraine into their home to watch the Super Bowl. Simple moments of generosity and hospitality that spoke volumes about both of them.

Colin made a lasting impression on my life, both professionally and personally. He helped shape how I think, how I share knowledge, and how I approach challenges.

My thoughts and deepest sympathies are with Lorraine and the family. I will remember Colin with great fondness and gratitude.
