Delores Lewis Springs passed away peacefully on Thursday, December 4, 2025, in Houston, TX, leaving behind a legacy of quiet strength and generosity. Delores was born on January 5, 1942, in Fort Worth, Texas. Delores was preceded in death by her parents, Angus V. “Jack” and Delores Lewis, and her beloved daughter, Katie Springs Krehmeier. She is survived by her husband of nearly six decades, Darryl Springs; son and daughter-in-law, Michael Springs and Jen Fabbi; and sister and brother-in-law, Elaine and Ingo Hentschel.

Delores graduated from Texas Tech University in 1964 with a Bachelor of Science degree in secondary education. After teaching for one year, she graduated in 1966 from University of Texas with a degree in library science. It was during this time in Austin, where she met Darryl. Delores and Darryl were married in Fort Worth on August 27, 1966. The couple relocated to Houston, where Delores became a school librarian at Alief Hastings High School and worked until her retirement.

Delores was an active volunteer at the Charity Guild of Catholic Women consignment shop, where she specialized in the book section. She found joy in playing bridge and canasta with her long-time friends, loved to read, and was a member of several book clubs. Over the years, Delores was a congregant of St. Michael’s, St. Cyril of Alexandria, and St. John Vianney Catholic parishes in Houston. She was a proud member of the Daughters of the American Revolution.
