Eileen Maloney Swearingen D'Agostino, our beautiful mother, grandmother, great grandmother, aunt and friend, passed away Wednesday, August 31, 2011 at the age of 96. Eileen was born June 2, 1915 to James and Helen Maloney in Ennis-Keane, County Cork, Ireland. She moved to Chicago at the age of two and was raised the third of six children: Mary, Jim, Peggy, John, and Ray in a loving, Catholic family.
