Frank Granados, Jr., 71, of Houston, Texas, passed away Sunday, February 14, 2021. Mr. Granados was born March 15, 1949, in Houston, Texas, to Francisco Granados and Jesusita Eureste Granados. After a hard fight, Frank passed away in ICU from Pneumonia and complications from Covid-19. He is survived by his wife Aurora Granados of 50 years. Frank was gentle (a gentleman) and he was a legend leaving behind a huge legacy. Above all, Frank was a man of God. A devoted Catholic who was raised in the church and knew the word of the Lord.
