Genevieve Ruth Beck passed away peacefully in Houston on Wednesday, January 8, 2025, at the age of 83. Jean was born on August 14, 1941 in McKeesport, Pennsylvania. Jean helped start the Ladies' Guild at the parish, and she continued to serve as Treasurer until the time of her passing. Together, Jean and Chuck demonstrated their devotion to the Catholic Church through both time and generous contributions as a reflection of their support.

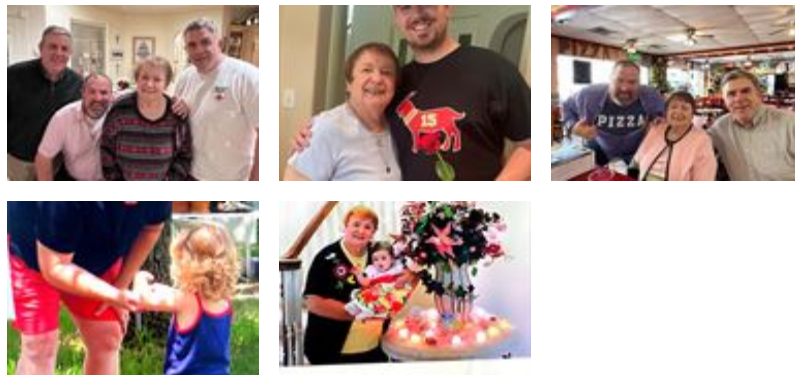
