Our son, Karl, was a longtime friend of Mike’s and knew Mike from middle school and stayed in touch with him all these years. He called us a few days ago and told us of Mike’s passing. Karl remembers Mike as a faithful, loyal, and devoted friend who he could call on anytime he was in a jam or needed a favor. Mike would always come through. Karl was working in Fort Worth a couple of weeks ago. Mike was going to drive up there and meet him and the two of them were going to spend a day at Six Flags. Unfortunately, Karl had to cancel because he was working a lot of long hours and was exhausted. He deeply regrets that. Karl talked to Mike a few days before his death and said he seemed to be okay. We no longer live in the Mission Bend area and moved in 2012 to where we are now near the George Ranch, which is about 20 miles from Mission Bend. Karl lived with us for a while and in April of last year, wrecked his vehicle and needed a ride to a car dealer on the east side of Houston to pick up another car he found. He didn’t have a way to get there, so he called up Mike. Mike drove all the way out here and gave Karl a ride there. That’s the kind of guy he was – a dependable and loyal friend. He was always willing to drop whatever he was doing to help a friend in need. I had not seen Mike for years. I believe the last time was when he and Karl were about 14 or 15. But, their friendship stood the test of time. Karl and Mike stayed in touch and though sometimes they might not see other for weeks or even months, they always picked up where they left off. I hope what little I know and have shared with you about my son’s friendship with Mike brings some comfort to the terrible sadness and pain of losing him. 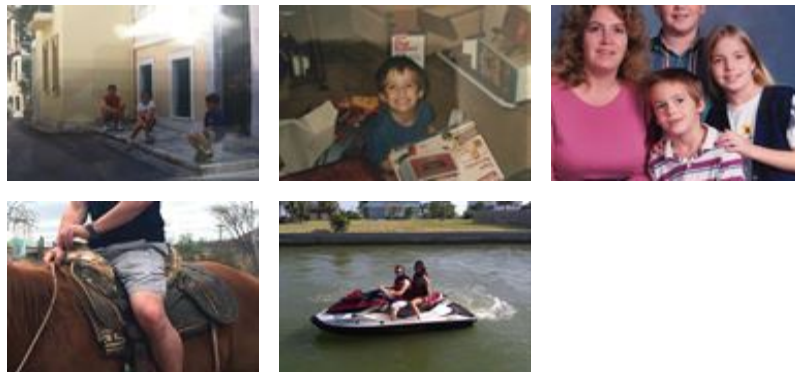

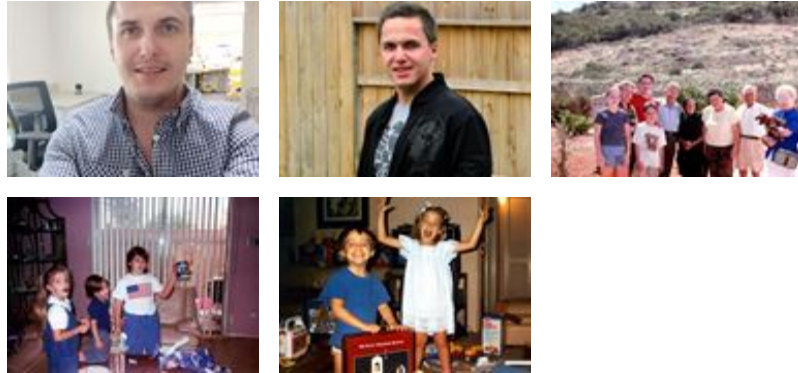
