She told the greatest stories of days gone by. Made a mean pizza. Laughed in the sweetest way.

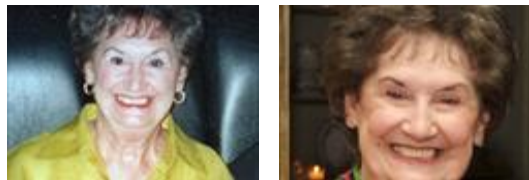
