Jan Price Leach, a native Houstonian, passed away June 21, 2017. She is survived by her husband, Richard P. Leach; son, Richard Leach; daughter, Allison Leach; and grandchildren, Alex, Taylor, and Madison Leach.

She was born January 8, 1933, to Claude and Gladys Price. She graduated from San Jacinto High School and received a Bachelor of Arts from Rice University in 1954. She was a charter member of Holy Spirit Episcopal Church, she founded Holy Spirit Episcopal School in 1962, and she served as headmistress for many years. Jan was devoted to her church, became the first female Senior Warden in 1979, and is currently serving on the Vestry. She pursued her passion of English antique silver as a show dealer known as Clifton House Antiques, and she served as president of the Houston Antique Dealers Association from 2002-2003. She retired in 2015.

Jan was a true Southern lady, adored and beloved by those who knew her. She was devoted to her husband of 63 years and together they traveled the world. She was a wonderful and caring mother and endowed both of her children with her strong sense of moral purpose. She will be remembered for her wit, sense of humor, and radiant smile. Jan will live in our hearts forever.
