Jason Joseph Guillory, 35, of Houston passed away Monday, January 4, 2021. Jason was born August 30, 1985 in New Orleans, Louisiana to Kathi and Joe Guillory. 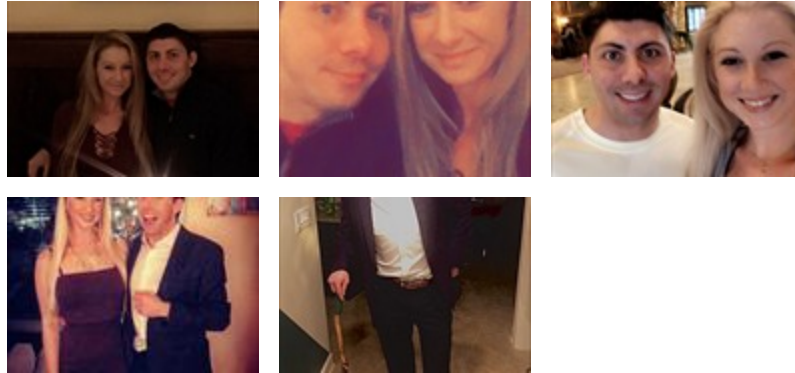

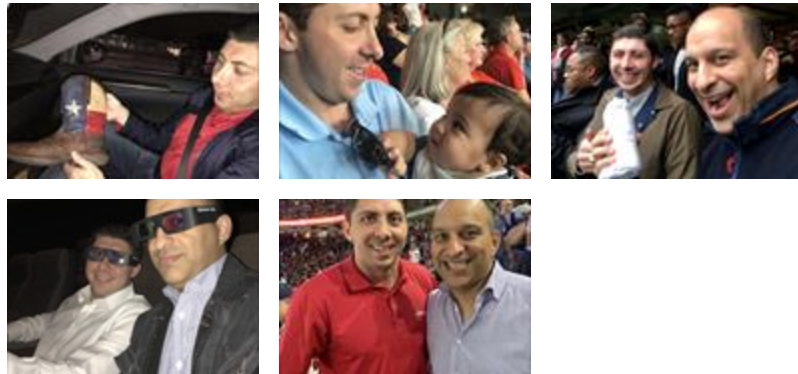

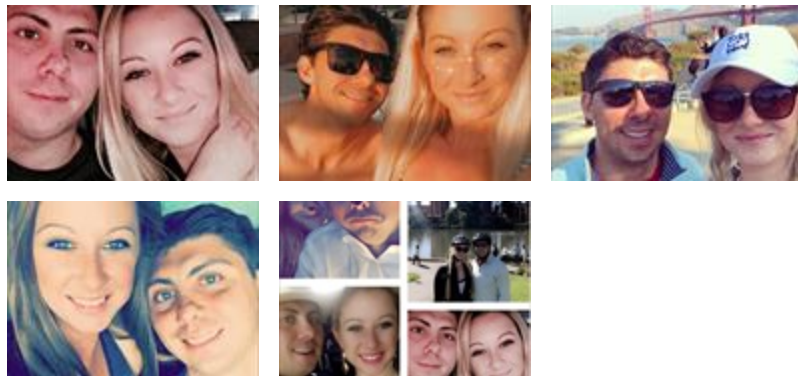
