John Allen Logan of Houston, Texas passed away on August 14th, 2023 at Parkway Place retirement home in Houston, Texas. John was born on December 29, 1929, in Kansas City, Missouri to the late Glenn W. and Grace Logan.

John (Jack) graduated from Kansas State University in 1951 with a Business Administration Degree in Accounting and was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity. Jack met his beautiful future bride, Barbara LuAnn Moore, in speech class at Kansas State and they were happily married in 1950 and shared 68 wonderful years together.
