Kathleen Kay McNamara Bevans age 84, died January 14, 2025, in Houston, Texas. Born in New Orleans, Louisiana, on October 12, 1940, she was the youngest child of John and Marion McNamara. She graduated from Dominican High School and Loyola University in New Orleans, where she met the love of her life, Thomas Bevans.

Kathleen was married 58 years to Tom, who preceded her in death. She is survived by five children: MaryKay and husband Clint Schroff, and Thomas M. Kathleen continued her work at the Sylvan Learning Center in Katy, Texas, where she had the privilege of teaching so many remarkable, beautiful children. She was a mentor to students at Northbrook Senior High School through her church, St. John

Vianney, and was a 10-year volunteer at Texas Children's Hospital. Kathleen loved reading and was devoted to helping others love it as well. Among her many interests were travelling worldwide and experiencing new places with her beloved Tom, deepening her knowledge of her Catholic faith, and spending time at the beach in Galveston. Her greatest joy was being with her grandchildren and great grandchildren, eating ice cream, celebrating Mardi Gras, and watching them pursue their dreams.
