



Margaret Anne Cutt

November 10, 1931 - April 22, 2015

Margaret Anne Cutt passed away April 22 at Clarewood House, surrounded by love. Born in Kelvington, Canada on 10th. November 1931, where her parents, Jim and Dorothy Mummery, were eking out a living in the bitter conditions of a Saskatchewan winter.

They returned to Womenswold, Kent, England where Margaret attended a 2-room schoolhouse from which she was the first student to achieve admission to Simon Langton Girl's School. She worked on the farm where her dad worked. She won a Scholarship to Southampton University from which she graduated with honors in Zoology. While there, she met her husband-to-be, Peter, with whom she shared her married life of nearly 62 years. In 1966 they emigrated to the USA with their three children.

She is survived by her husband, her brother Harry(his wife Hilda), children Barbara Tessin(husband David), Christine Newsham(husband Scott) , and Timothy Cutt(wife Carolyn), and by her grandchildren, Stephanie Proulx(husband Joe) and Allyson Tessin, Rebecca and Katie Newsham, and Christopher(wife Ashleigh) and Matthew Cutt, and by great granddaughter, Lexi Proulx.

Margaret excelled in the Varsity sports of rowing, lacrosse and badminton and later acquired a love of tennis, and was a member of Westside Tennis Club

since 1979. She was a professional Tennis Umpire officiating at many major tournaments. She loved mountain trekking, spending her 59th birthday at 19,500ft. looking down on the base camp of Everest during a 22 day high altitude trek

She was an active member of Ashford United Methodist church and completed five international construction missions with the church and Habitat for Humanity. She served on the Board of Directors of WESM, the forerunner of West Houston Assistance Ministries.
