of her grandchildren, she exuded a joy for life and could make any situation fun.

Her family remembers her as an incredible homemaker, wonderful cook, and a person with an open heart for others. She was extremely dedicated to her family, taking great delight in creating a wonderful home for them. She was charitable and generous, sensing when others were struggling or had a need, and never hesitated to reach out and help in any way she could, whether big or small. She was always a shining example of how to treat others with God's love, great kindness and respect.

She is survived by her daughters Erin Brown and Julie McMahon, son in law Kevin McMahon, of Houston, as well as five grandchildren: Joe, Gwyneth, David, Lillian and Genevieve McMahon who adored her and loved spending time with their grandmother "ReRe." They will miss her dearly. She is preceded in death by her husband, Joseph Louis Brown, Jr. (Brownie) and her son, Joseph Louis Brown, III (Louis).
