Marvin Emil Adamek, 87, of Houston peacefully passed away Saturday, April 29, 2023. Marvin was born August 19, 1935 in Schulenburg, Texas to Emil Joe Adamek and Francis Rose Gassmann Adamek. He is preceded in death by his parents, his wife Bernadett Adamek and grandson Jason Carson. He was a very devoted member of Holy Cross Catholic Church in East Bernard and served as Chaplain with the Knights of Columbus 4th Degree for many years.

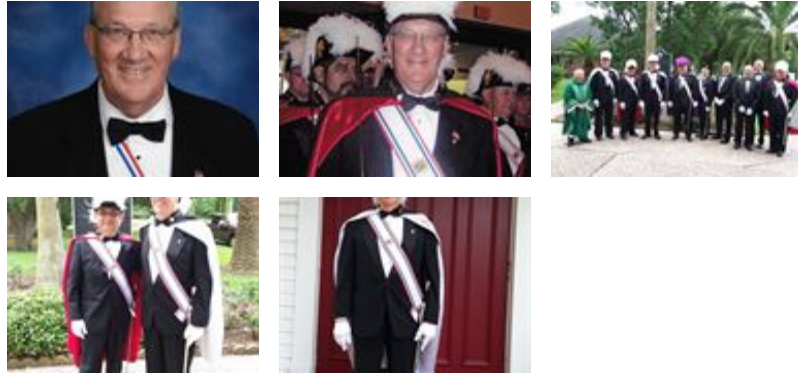
