



Marvin Glenn Bocox Jr.

September 28, 1932 - May 3, 2017

Glenn was born in an oil company house in Oklahoma. His family soon followed the oil boom to Southern IL where his career in the oil industry started as a 15-year-old roughneck on a cable tool rig. Managing an oilfield supply company, he moved from Illinois to Louisiana and Texas, retiring in Houston as a salesman of oilfield tubular goods, after owning a once thriving company in the industry. Following retirement, he worked for Enterprise Rent-A-Car enjoying the company of fellow retirees. He was proud of his donation of 55 gallons of blood to the Houston Blood Bank and his participation in four MS-150 bike rides, his last one at age 72.

He is survived by his grade school sweetheart, Mary Ann, his wife of 65 years, sons Jamie (Penny), and Robert, three grandsons Charlie (Rebecca), Ellory and Brady, granddaughter, Julia Ann, and nieces, Jane and Jean Morgan.
