Mary Rose Davis Propes, 79, went to be with her Lord and Savior Wednesday, June 22, 2016.

Mary was born in Overton, Texas, on July 11, 1936 and grew up in “The Heights,” Houston, Texas. She graduated from John Reagan High School and attended University of Houston.

Mary was united in marriage to Richard Lynn “Glen” Propes, the love of her life, on April 18, 1956 in “The Heights”, Houston, Texas. He preceded her in death May 1, 2014. They were married for 58 blissful years.

From 1968 to 1992, Mary worked as a trust officer and administrative assistant at Bank of America. She, then, retired to take care of her husband and family.
