November 13, 1959 - March 25, 2023

Dr. Trish Eileen Crane Storey, 63, of Houston passed away peacefully, surrounded by her loving family on Saturday, March 25, 2023. She was born November 13, 1959 in Akron, OH to Edward and Grace Crane. She is preceded in death by her parents; nephews, Timmy and Brian Crane; and brother, Terry Crane. She is survived by her loving husband of 31 years, Mark Storey; children, Mark and Shannon Storey, brothers, Edward and wife Barbara Crane and Peter and wife Kristen Crane; mother-in-law Marie Storey; sisters-in-law Sharon Storey and husband Elliott Loviolette, Dr. Michele Storey and husband Rod Desroches, and Allison Jones; and brother-in-law Mike Jones. She is also survived by her 8 nieces and nephews.

Trish was educated at Sacred Heart Academy, Muhlenberg College, and UTMB John Sealy School of Medicine. A devoted wife, mother, and pediatrician, Trish effortlessly juggled the demands of each role and was a source of compassion, patience, and love with all whom she came in contact. Trish derived her life's purpose from her career in medicine, which spanned over 30 years and culminated in her tenure at Great Kids Pediatrics ("GKP"), where she practiced with Dr. Abel J. Paredes, Dr. Ann Schroeder Lee, and Dr. Karen Zorilla. From her patients and their families to her fellow staff, Trish loved each and every member of her GKP Family and passionately worked there from 2002 up until her last days. When Trish wasn't seeing patients, you could find her cheering on the Astros, enjoying a glass of red wine, or listening

to George Strait.

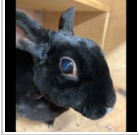
