May 18, 1942 - August 27, 2023

Patricia (Pat) Noonan Hartberger passed away peacefully on August 27, 2023. She was born in Fort Wayne, Indiana in 1942 and graduated from Central Catholic High School and Indiana University-Bloomington. She married Ronald John Hartberger in 1985.

Her career was spent largely with Texaco and later with The Associates and Citibank. After retiring in 2006, she enjoyed volunteer work with Citizens for Animal Protection and the Charity Guild of Catholic Women Resale Shop, a children's charity. She was a member of St. John Vianney Catholic Church and Theresians International. Pat had a variety of interests, including opera, Shakespeare, travel, dancing, hiking, country/western music, and composing casual and witty poetry for special occasions. Pat was compassionate, generous, and a beloved friend to many.

Pat has one sister, Sheila Steketee (wife of Peter Steketee), one niece (Amy Steketee Fox), and two nephews (Aaron Steketee and Matthew Steketee).
