Peter Frederic Walbridge passed away at age 68 on March 8th, 2018 in Houston, Texas. He was born in Detroit, Michigan on April 28th, 1949. He grew up in Houston, Texas. As a young man he blazed his own path across the world, living in Nepal, India, Mexico, and Tahiti. He was a musician, a farmer, a history and anthropology buff, a raconteur, and a devoted husband and father. He was active in his sons' sports, the food pantry, and the Boy Scouts.

He was predeceased by his father, Willard E. Walbridge and his mother, Marietta Walbridge. He was survived by his wife, Mary Walbridge, and his two sons, Peter F. Walbridge Jr. and Patrick W. Walbridge, his aunt, Ruth Stoner, and her family.
