Ralph William Dunn was born October 3, 1964 in Houston, Texas and died October 25, 2011. He was the son of the late William Lee Dunn and Searcy Miller Dunn. Ralph grew up in Houston, Texas with his younger sister Dorothy Lee. He graduated from The High School for Performing and Visual Arts (HSPVA) and from Texas Lutheran University. Ralph was a member of the Texas State Guard and served his community and state during Hurricane Katrina. At different times during his life he was a public school teacher, an entrepreneur, and a skillful computer programmer/analyst. Ralph was also a talented and gifted writer, poet, multi-faceted artist and photographer whose humor, wit and intelligence will be greatly missed.
