He was a member of the Aggie Singing Cadets. While he was at Texas A&M he met his wife of 61 years, Margie, who worked at the University. He served in both the Army and Air Force Reserves. After college, he also worked with young kids in Junior Achievement. He was employed by Mosher Steel Company for 40 years. He served as Vice President of sales which included contracts for the steel fabrication of many high-rise buildings, power plants and numerous steel bridges across the country, including the Houston ship channel bridge, Beltway 8 interchanges, and The World Trade Centers.

He and Margie enjoyed their time as youth leaders at Grace Presbyterian, where they have been members since 1974. Dick enjoyed playing tennis, golf, and fishing. For many years Dick and Margie enjoyed their season tickets cheering on their beloved Aggie football team. He mostly loved attending the many activities of his grandchildren.
