



## Richard Edward Talbot

April 19, 1952 - October 10, 2024

Richard Edward Talbot ("Rick") of Houston, TX, passed away October 10, 2024. Rick was born on April 19, 1952, in Fort Bragg, North Carolina to Raymond Joseph Talbot and Carolyn Talbot. He is preceded in death by his father, mother and brothers Robert Charles Talbot, Roger Jay Talbot and Raymond Stewart Talbot. He is survived by his wife of 32 years, Rose Talbot, stepson Joseph Coy and favorite grandson Milo Coy; sisters Sandra McMinn and husband, Edward Weinman, and Barbara Ellen Prevost, brothers Ronald Arthur Talbot and wife Francis Talbot, Randy James Talbot and wife Cathy Talbot and many loving nieces, nephews and cousins.

Rick grew up in a military family living in many different places until the age of 8. The family moved to Slidell, Louisiana where Rick graduated in 1970 from Salmon High School. Upon graduation, Rick joined the U.S. Air Force and served 8 years. Following his discharge, he attended USL in LaFayette, Louisiana and received his MBA from the University of St. Thomas in Houston, TX. His career consisted of several positions as Administrator of medical clinics and hospital organizations in Texas. Rick went to work at Houston Methodist Hospital - TMH Physicians Organization in May 2007, and served as ACDM Department Administrator in the Department of Anesthesia. In May 2015, he served as Administrator - Department of Medicine until his retirement in 2021. In retirement he served as usher at St. John Vianney Catholic Church, did volunteer work in a variety of causes, and served on the

Board of Directors of the Big Creek Ranch POA.

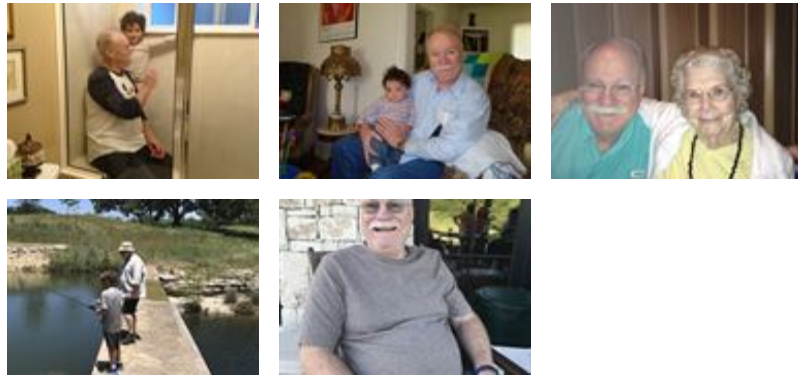
