Robert Sherman Moore II, age 59, ended his courageous battle with pancreatic cancer on December 4, 2013 and is now resting in the arms of his Lord Jesus Christ. Rob was born December 18, 1953 in Chanute, Kansas to Robert and Joyce Moore. He graduated from Ottawa University with a BBA and earned his MBA from Southern Methodist University. Rob married Robin Capper Moore on August 20, 1976 and they began their life together in Houston, Texas. He loved being the proud father of Lindsay, Bobby and Alex, his greatest accomplishments, and in recent years welcomed the role of “Baba” and “Granddad” to Samantha, Stephen, Jillian and Matthew.

Rob, an accomplished pianist, loved music of all genres, but not as much as he loved his sports. Basketball topping the list, Rob played for both his Shawnee Mission South Raiders and his Ottawa University Braves. Rob was an avid Kansas Jayhawk fan; March Madness, his favorite holiday! He was always racing from work to coach one of his kids’ teams or to attend the games of his young friends.

Rob devoted his life to teaching young men and women how to live godly lives. 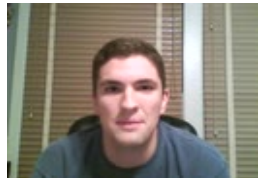
