Shari Michael Brummel, 83, of Houston, TX, passed away peacefully on June 1, 2026.

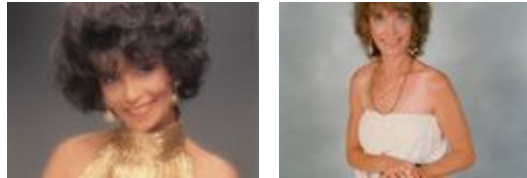

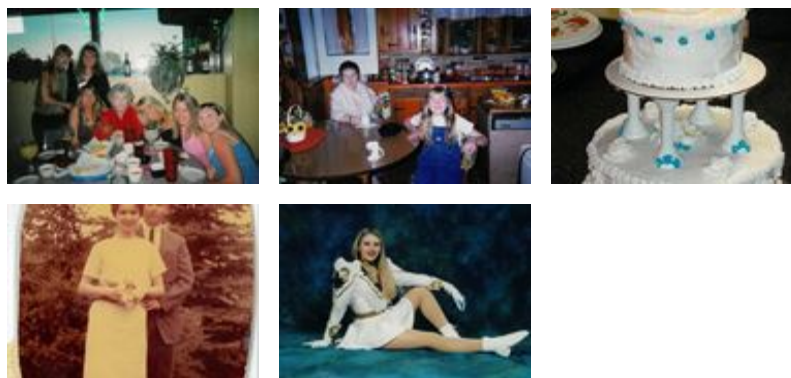
