Shirley M. Thompson, 80, passed away September 10, 2010 in Katy, TX, after a long battle with Alzheimer's disease. Shirley was born October 9, 1929, in Pittsfield, MA, to William Doyle and Catherine McNeice. After graduating from high school and secretarial school in Boston, MA, Shirley got her first job at Mutual Boiler Insurance Company where she met her future husband, Charles F. Thompson. They were married on September 9, 1951 and had two daughters. Shirley spent most of those years being a loving wife and mother while raising her family in Flourtown, PA and Millville, NJ. After moving to Lafayette, LA in 1981, Shirley became a Mary Kay consultant and with the confidence gained from that she started her modeling career at the age of 65. 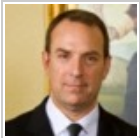
