Wiley Chase Anderson, loving Husband, Father, Grandfather, Great Grandfather and Friend went to be with Our Lord on July 8, 2016.

He was born April 5, 1934 to Bernard Axel Anderson and Jean Reed Anderson in Galveston. He graduated from Ball High School where he played guard on the football team. Anderson began working for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company in 1952 until 1954 when he joined the army. He married Carol Jean Green on August 28, 1954, and returned to Southwestern Bell after leaving the service. Later he began classes at the University of Houston, and become an Engineering Manager with Southwestern Bell. He retired in 1986, continuing then as a contractor.

Wiley was a member at St. Cecilia's Catholic Church where he served as a Boy Scout Leader, an Usher, and with the St. Vincent de Paul Charity. He was a member and a Past Grand Knight of the Knights of Columbus Memorial Council 6527 and a past president of the Northwest Serra Club. Wiley is survived by his wife, 3 children, 17 grandchildren, and 6 great-grandchildren.
